Notice of Service Reduction: Ozaukee Shared Ride Taxi

March 23, 2020

As part of our ongoing response to the COVID-19 epidemic, Ozaukee County is limiting Shared Ride Taxi service to essential travel. "Essential" travel is being defined as medical, food related, and employment. This reduction of service will be effective Tuesday, March 24, 2020 until further notice.

The safety of our drivers and limiting the spread of COVID-19 in the community are our top concerns. Ozaukee Shared Ride continues to be available to the public for essential travel. All taxi vehicles are cleaned and sanitized daily. Hand sanitizer is available for passengers and drivers to use.

We ask that riders follow these guidelines to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 while in transit vehicles:

- Cover your cough with your elbow or wear a mask.
- Use the online payment system instead of cash. Please call Ozaukee Shared Ride at 262-284-8294 to set up an account.
- Observe social distancing; keep space between you and other riders

Information and mandates are changing rapidly as more is being learned about the pandemic, and what we need to do to flatten the curve. We will continue to post updates to changes in services as they are formalized.
