### **Ozaukee County Express Bus (MCTS 143) Suspended**

To Our Riders:

As we all join together to combat the COVID 19 virus, many work and commuting habits have changed rapidly. This has resulted in a steep decline in passengers aboard the Ozaukee County Express- MCTS Route 143. As part of the ongoing response to the COVID 19 outbreak, and in alignment with MCTS' service reduction, Ozaukee County Express service will be suspended **beginning Monday, March 23 until further notice.**

For those still needing to commute to Downtown Milwaukee, please note that our Shared Ride Taxi service would be able to drop you off and pick you up at two locations in Brown Deer to connect with MCTS: The Brown Deer Park/Ride lot (Brown Deer Rd. at I-43) (MCTS Rt. 63) and Green Bay Road and Schroeder Drive (MCTS Rt. 12).
