**OZAUKEE COUNTY TRANSIT SERVICES -  
Public Hearing on Ozaukee County Commuter  
Bus Service**

A public hearing will be held by the Ozaukee County Public Works Committee on August 10, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. to determine the need to continue the Ozaukee County Express Bus service (MCTS Route 143). The public hearing will be at the Ozaukee County Administration Center - Auditorium, 121 W Main Street, Port Washington.

The Ozaukee County Express is a service of Ozaukee County, and is operated by Milwaukee County Transit Services through a contract that expires January 1, 2023. Ozaukee County has provided this service since 1998. Ridership has been in decline for the past 10 years, and has not yet recovered from a dramatic drop during the COVID-19 pandemic. Comments from the public are invited and will be heard on the need to continue commuter bus service between Ozaukee County and Milwaukee County.

Comments can be delivered orally or in writing. All written comments will be read to the Public Works Committee at the hearing on Aug 10th. Written comments must be received by 8:00 am on Aug 10th to be included in the discussion packet.
